

# Bengalw

Known for its pleasant climate throughout the year and being the capital city of Karnataka, Bengaluru has emerged as the world's fastest-growing tech ecosystem. With growing tech companies, startups, and industries, Bengaluru is known as the "Silicon Valley of India" and as the "IT capital of India." Blessed with a number of parks and gardens, the City is also famous as the Garden City of India. Bengaluru is a vibrant cosmopolitan and multicultural City with a number of enchanting places of tourist interest in and around the City; a few of these are highlighted.



#### Vidhana Soudha

29 km away from the venue, Vidhana Soudha is the largest legislative building in India. It is a 175 ft tall structure with architecture from the styles of the medieval Chalukya, Hoysala, and Vijayanagara Empires. This magnificent building was built in 1956 and cost about 180 lakhs INR.



#### **Bangalore** Palace

Constructed in 1878, Bangalore Palace is a majestic structure built in Tudor Revival style architecture and decorated with elegant wood carvings, floral motifs, cornices, and relief paintings on the ceilings. The 35-room palace which is 27 km away from the Venue is a must-visit attraction.







### **Cubbon Park**

Sri Chamarajendra Park also known as Cubbon Park was originally created in 1870 and covers 300 acres of land. It has a variety of flora and fauna and is situated 31 km away from the Venue.

#### **Bannerghatta National Park**

Bannerghatta National Park is located 66 km away from the venue. With ancient temples, trekking, hiking, and safari rides this place is a complete package to spend the entire day!





#### Lalbagh

Lalbagh Botanical Gardens constructed in the 1760s is located 32 km away from the Venue. The garden has a lake adjoining a large rock on which one of the four watch towers of Bengaluru is situated.

National Military Memorial

National Military Memorial is situated within the premises of Indira Gandhi Musical Fountain and is 27 km away from the venue. Spread over 7.5 acres this is the country's first monument to honour soldiers who laid their lives in major wars post-independence.





#### Visveshwaraya Museum

29 kms away from the venue, is the Vishveswaraya Industrial and Technological Museum. It was set up in 1962 and has various exhibition galleries related to science and technology.

#### Jawaharlal Nehru Planetarium

Jawaharlal Planetarium is 27 km away from the venue. This place has shows about the solar system with hybrid projection systems installed. This place is a knowledge hub about space science.





#### **Innovative Film City**

67 km away from the venue, Innovative Film City is an innovative theme park. There are multiple theme-based activity centers that are most enjoyable for the whole family.

#### Wonderla

One of the best amusement parks in the world and 57 km away from the venue is the Wonderla amusement park. With more than 60 rides in water and on land, this is a whole-day outing for people to relax and enjoy.







#### **ISKCON** Temple

30 km away from the venue, Iskcon Temple is one of the largest Krishna temples in the world. The temple has a 17 m high gold-plated Dhwaja Stambha and an 8.5 m high Kalasa Shikara. This Dravidian style temple is very peaceful, pleasant, and well-maintained.

#### Gavi Gangadareshwara Temple

One of the best places to see Indian-rock cut architecture is the Gavipuram cave "Gavigangadareshwara temple". Built in the Vedic period and renovated in the 16th century & dedicated to Lord Shiva, it is 36 km away from the venue The speciality of the Venue is the marvellous architecture. Every year only on the day of Makar Sankranti the sun rays fall directly on the idol of Lord Shiva.



#### Isha Foundation Chikkaballapur

ISHA FOUNDATION CHIKKABALLAPUR is a spiritual center located 46 km away which was constructed and inaugurated recently. Amidst the beautiful infrastructure stands the statue of Adi Yogi.



Shree Bhoghanandeshwara Swami Temple

Shree Bhoganandeshwara temple and Arunachaleshwara temple are twin temples built in the 8th and 9th centuries by the Pallava Dynasty. Later there were restorations by the Vijayanagar empire. The temple dedicated to Lord Shiva has Nolambavadi-style Dravidian culture and is 29 km away from the venue. There is great architecture and beautiful stone carvings on the walls and pillars of the Temple.





#### Avalabetta

68 km away from the venue, Avalabetta is a great trekking destination with the joy of sightseeing and photography. It is a 2-hour trek to the peak of the hill and an early morning trek would give great vibes.

#### Nandi Hills

33 km away from the venue, Nandi Hills is a picturesque place to visit. The 4,849 ft hill is famous for its Sunrise. On the way to the hill comes the Growing Bull (Nandi) Temple. Nandi Hills is a great place for a day trip with family and friends.
